



<p>BYE LAW No. I MEMBERSHIP</p> <p>Rule No.1- The members of the Lodge shall comprise three classes, viz.</p> <p>(a). Resident Members. (b). Non-Resident Members. (c). Honorary Members.</p> <p>Explanation: 1. At the Regular Meeting in January the Lodge shall appoint a Screening Committee consisting of three senior brethren of the Lodge in good standing. The Worshipful Master and Secretary as ex officio members.</p> <p>18(b). The duties of the Screening Committee shall be, to meet every candidate proposed initiation or every brother proposed for joining or rejoining, to ascertain the suitability of the Candidate /brother, may visit the candidate's/brother's home and/ or his place of work, meet with his family and may make any such enquiry due enquiry to its satisfaction; to submit report with its recommendations about the candidate(s) to the Standing Committee at its next meeting.</p> <p>18(c). The duties of the Building Committee shall be; to periodically inspect the Lodge building and report with its recommendation for improvements, repairs and maintenance if any, to the Standing Committee; to carry out the work subject to the approval of the Lodge with due report to the Standing Committee.
-Nil-	18(e). At the Regular Meeting in January the Lodge shall appoint a Charity Committee consisting of three senior brethren of the Lodge. The Worshipful Master, Treasurer and Secretary as ex officio members.
-Nil-	18(f). The duties of the Charity Committee shall be; to submit its report with its recommendations of the charity projects to be implemented if any, to be taken up by the Lodge for the benefit of the community at large; to prepare and submit a budget for the charity project for the ensuing year to allocate funds by the Lodge for the implementation of the Charity project to the Standing Committee before the Installation Meeting; to submit its report annually of the projects undertaken to the Standing Committee before the Installation Meeting.


