Existing By-Laws

Amended By-Laws

By-Law No..... **19 (3)**

He shall receive for the proper discharge of his duties a sum not more than Rs.50/- for every meeting of such other remuneration as the Lodge may vote from time to time.

(4) If a subscribing member is elected or officiates as Tyler of the Lodge he shall not be entitled to any such remuneration.

(5) The Tyler elected or officiate shall be exempted from payment of dinner charges.

Bye-law No.21 Master's Imprest:

A sum of Rupees Fifty (50) shall be placed at the disposal of the Master for Charitable purpose during the tenure of his office. For all amounts over that sum, the sanction of the Lodge shall be obtained. The Master will report any reliefs at the next regular meeting and at the end of the year, the balance, if any, will be carried to the charity account.

By-Law No..... **19 (3)**

He shall receive for proper discharge of his duties a sum not more than Rs.75/- for every meeting of such other remuneration as the Lodge may vote from time to time.

(4) If a subscribing member is elected or officiates as Tyler of the Lodge he shall not be entitled to any such remuneration.

(5) The Tyler elected or officiates shall be exempted from payment of dinner charges.

Bye-law No.21 Master's Imprest:

A sum of Rupees Two Hundred (200) shall be placed at the disposal of the Master for Charitable purpose during the tenure of his office. For all amounts over that sum, the sanction of the Lodge shall be obtained. The Master will report any reliefs at the next regular meeting and at the end of the year, the balance, if any will be carried to the charity account.
