## PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO / REVISED BY LAWS

(To be Submitted in Triplicate)

Existing By-Laws	Amended By-Laws
<p>By-Law No.. <b>RULE : 4</b></p> <p>There shall be a Permanent Committee consisting of the Master, the two Wardens, the Treasurer, the Secretary and all the Past Masters of the Lodge, ex-officio, and two Master-Masons, not being office-bearers elected by the brethren in open Lodge, at the Installation Meeting. Five shall constitute the quorum for business.</p> <hr/> <p><b>RULE : 14</b></p> <p>When a Member's subscription is unpaid, for a period of three months, the Secretary shall send him an intimation thereof; and, call upon him to pay up his subscription and state that in the event of failure to pay up the dues, a report will be made at the next regular meeting of the Lodge for further instructions. If the Lodge were to direct the issue of a notice under Rule 156 Book of Constitutions, the Secretary shall thereupon send the said notice by registered post, acknowledgement due, at least fourteen days before the date of the meeting at which the proposition for exclusion will be moved.</p>	<p>By-Law No. <b>RULE : 4</b></p> <p>There shall be a Permanent Committee consisting of the Master, the two Wardens, the Treasurer, the Secretary and all the Past Masters of the Lodge, ex-officio, and two Master-Masons, elected by the brethren in open Lodge, at the Installation Meeting. Five shall constitute the quorum for business.</p> <hr/> <p><b>RULE : 14</b></p> <p>When a Member's subscription is unpaid, for a period of three months, the Secretary shall send him an intimation thereof; and, while pointing out to him that the subscription dues are being regularly indicated in the summons every month, call upon him to pay up his arrears immediately. If the Member's dues remain unpaid even at the end of six months from the date of such Notice, the Secretary shall again remind him to pay up his dues and caution him that Rule 124 of the B of C shall operate at the end of one year. Thereafter, if the Member fails to pay up his dues even at the end of the year, Rule 124 of the B of C shall operate for automatic cessation of Membership.</p>

The above amendments were regularly Proposed and Seconded in open Lodge at a regular Meeting held on 5th July, 2003 Passed at a regular Meeting held on 2nd August, 2003 and confirmed at a regular Meeting held on 6th September, 2003
