<p>By-Law No.....</p> <p><u>By-law No.19</u></p> <p>A fee of Rs.20/- shall be paid by each brother on whose account an Emergency Meeting is called in addition to the fees if any, payable under By-law No.71 of the Regional Grand Lodge.</p> <p><u>By-Law No.24.</u></p> <p>Any member whose dues to the Lodge shall remain unpaid for three months, shall after due notice given him in accordance with Rule 156 of the Book of Constitutions, be liable to be excluded from the Lodge. If he should wish to rejoin, he must again be balloted for and pay the joining fee and all arrears.</p> <p><u>By-law No.34.</u></p> <p>The Lodge funds shall not be appropriated for any entertainments or refreshments excepting the aggregate sum not exceeding one rupee seventy-five naye paise per mensem for each resident member and non-resident office-bearer.</p>	<p>By-Law No.....</p> <p><u>By-Law No. 19</u></p> <p>A fee of Rs.1000/- shall be paid by the Brother or jointly by the Brethren on whose account an Emergency Meeting is called in addition to the fees, if any, payable under By-law No.71 of the Regional Grand Lodge.</p> <p><u>By-Law No.. 24</u></p> <p>Any member whose dues to the Lodge shall remain unpaid for three months from the due date, shall after due notice given him in accordance with Rule 156 of the Book of Constitutions, be liable to be excluded from the Lodge. If he should wish to rejoin, he must again be balloted for and pay the joining fee and all arrears.</p> <p><u>By-Law No.34.</u></p> <p>The Lodge funds other than the Stewards Fund shall not be appropriated for any entertainments or refreshments.</p>
