1.	3(a)	The Lodge shall consist of Resident, Non Resident, Life Members and Members not liable to pay subscription. a. Resident Members are those residing within 25 kms from the limits of the Bangalore Corporation.	The Lodge shall consist of Resident, Non-Resident, Life Members and Members not liable to pay subscription. a. Resident Members are those residing within 35 kms from the limits of the Bangalore Corporation.
2.	5(i)	The subscription payable by members shall be as follows :- i. GL and RGL dues that are current for the whole year shall be paid in the month of January every year by resident members, non-resident members, life members, not liable to pay subscription.	The subscription payable by members shall be as follows :- i. GL and RGL dues that are current for the whole year shall be paid in the month of January every year by resident members, non-resident members, life members, members not liable to pay subscription.
3.	5(a)	The resident members shall pay a sum of Rs.1,500/- P.A. as subscription. A Resident member shall however have an option of paying the annual subscription of Rs.1,500/- in two equal instalments in the month of January and July each year. The annual subscription of Rs.2,000/- will be due to be paid by a resident member irrespective of the date/month of initiation/joining/re-joining. The annual subscription shall become payable in advance during January each year. A Resident member shall however have an option of paying the annual subscription of Rs.2,000/- in two equal instalments in the month of January and July each year.
4.	5(ii)b	The Non Resident Members shall pay a sum of Rs.300/- per annum as subscription. The annual subscription of Rs.300/- will be due to be paid by a Non-resident Member irrespective of the date/ month of initiation/joining. The annual subscription shall become payable in advance during January each year.	Non-Resident Members shall pay a sum of Rs.1,000/- per annum as subscription along with GLI and RGL dues. The annual subscription of Rs.1,000/- will be due to be paid by a Non-resident Member irrespective of the date/ month of initiation/joining/ rejoining. The annual subscription as also GLI/ RGL dues shall become payable in advance during January each year.



5.	5 (iii)	Any member whose subscriptions or any portion thereof are in arrears for more than three months will not be eligible to vote, propose or second a candidate either for initiation or Joining or be eligible for being appointed to any office. (Rule 121B.C.)	Any member whose subscriptions or any portion thereof are in arrears for more than three months will not be eligible to vote, propose or second a candidate either for initiation or Joining/ rejoining or be eligible for being appointed to any office (Rule 121 B of C.) or vote at the Annual General Meeting of Lodge Bangalore Freemasons' Hall Trust.

If any member allows his dues to remain unpaid for 3 months, the Secretary shall issue intimation by registered letter to his last known address; and if the arrears are not cleared within one month from the date of issue of such registered letter, he shall be liable to be excluded under Rule 156 of B.C. No person shall be made a mason in, or admitted a member of a daughter lodge, unless if on ballot for initiation, joining/ rejoining simple majority of members present and voting in the lodge approve the proposal for such candidate. iii. The candidate rejected shall not be re-proposed until after the expiry of six months from the date of rejection. The same procedure mutatis mutandis applies to a joining member/ rejoining member.


