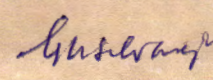
PROPOSED AMENDMENTS TO / ~~REVISED~~ BY LAWS (To be Submitted in Triplicate)

Existing By-Laws	Amended By-Laws
By-Law No. <u>I. Members:-</u> 2. Members residing within 10 Kms of Freemasons' Hall, Coorgaum, K.G.F. shall be deemed Resident Members 3. Members residing beyond 10 Kms limit for a period of not less than six months, may, on request be admitted Non-Resident Members <u>By-Law No. V - Emergency Meetings</u> 8. The holding of Emergency Meetings by dispensation shall be regulated by provisions of Rule 116 of B of C where a purpose of conferring a Degree at the request and for the convenience of a candidate the Lodge may collect from such candidate or candidates a total sum not exceeding Rs. 350/- towards the expenses of the Meeting. <u>By Law No. VIII- Balloting</u> 12. No candidate shall be made a Mason and no Brother shall be admitted as Member of this Lodge if on ballot being taken three black balls appear against him. If the Master is of the opinion that a mistake may have occurred in the Ballot he may order a second ballot to be taken forthwith which shall be final.	By-Law No. <u>I. Members:-</u> 2. Members residing within 40 Kms of Freemasons' Hall, Coorgaum, K.G.F. shall be deemed Resident Members. 3. Members residing at beyond 40 Kms limit permanently or for a period of not less than six months, may be admitted or Initiated as Non-Resident Members. <u>By-Law No. V - Emergency Meetings.</u> 8. The holding of Emergency Meetings by Dispensation shall be regulated by provisions of Rule 116 of B of C where a purpose of conferring a Degree at the request and for the convenience of a candidate or candidates. the Lodge may collect from such candidate or candidates the total expenses of the Meeting and other expenses attended thereto as determined by the P.C. <u>By Law No. VIII - Balloting</u> Provisions of Rule 140 of B of C shall apply. It is provided that a period of atleast 12 months shall elapse before any rejected candidate can be re-proposed.

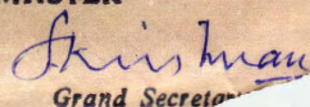

By-Law No. <u>VI. Fees & Subscription</u> C. Annual Subscription to Lodge The yearly subscription shall be paid as follows 1. Towards Membership to Lodge ₹ 300 2. Towards Benevolent/charity fund ₹ 30 3. Towards Stewards A/c ₹ 120 Plus dues to RGL/GLI <u>By-Law No. 15</u> Payment of any sum exceeding ₹ 50 may be made only by resolution of the Lodge, of which notice has been given in the Summons, except in a case of emergency, when such payment may be authorised by the Master, and confirmed by the Lodge at the next Regular Meeting	By-Law No. <u>VI. Fees and Subscription</u> C. Annual Subscription to Lodge The yearly subscription shall be paid as follows: 1. Towards Membership to Lodge ₹ 400 2. Towards Benevolent/Charity Fund ₹ 100 3. Towards Stewards A/c ₹ 150 4. Building Fund A/c ₹ 50 Plus dues to RGL and GLI <u>By-law No. 15</u> a. All payments including charity disbursements shall be authorised firstly by the P.C. and passed in the Open Lodge. b. All accounts in the name of the Lodge except otherwise specifically authorised authorised otherwise, will be operated by Treasurer along with the Secretary or Worshipful Master, jointly.
