

<p>By-Law No.....</p> <p><u>EXISTING BY-LAW NO: 17</u></p> <p>No candidate for Free Masonry shall be initiated if on the ballot two or more black balls appear against him.</p> <p><u>EXISTING BY-LAW NO: 18</u></p> <p>No brother shall be admitted as joining or re-joining member of the Lodge if on the ballot three or more black balls appear against him.</p> <p><u>EXISTING BY-LAW NO: 23 (a)</u></p> <p>If the subscription of a member remain unpaid for two full years, at the expiration of the period he shall cease to be a member of the Lodge, which fact shall be reported to the Lodge at the regular meeting and recorded in the minutes.</p>	<p>By-Law No.....</p> <p><u>AMENDED BY-LAW NO: 17</u></p> <p>No person shall be made a Mason unless if on ballot, two thirds of the members present and voting in the Lodge approve the proposal for such candidate.</p> <p><u>AMENDED BY-LAW NO: 18</u></p> <p>No brother shall be admitted as Joining or Re-joining member of the lodge, unless if on ballot, two thirds of the members present and voting in the Lodge approve the proposal for such candidate.</p> <p><u>AMENDED BY-LAW NO: 23(a)</u></p> <p>Should the subscription of a member of the Lodge remain unpaid for one full year at the expiration of the period he shall cease to be a member of all Lodges, provided such a member, has been duly served with a notice by Registered post with acknowledgement due of-being in arrears of the subscription amount and the member fails to make payment within 30 days of receipt of the notice. A copy of such notice shall also be sent to the Regional Grand Secretary.</p> <p>The fact of cessation shall be reported to the Lodge at the next regular meeting and recorded in the minutes and shall be forthwith notified to the Grand Secretary. The provisions of B of C Rules 9A, 138,150 and157 shall apply in the case of a Brother ceasing to be a member under this Rule as if he had been excluded by vote.</p> <p>Such a member can only become a member again by regular proposition and ballot according to B of C Rule 138 provided he has made payment of the arrears of all Lodges, which will be a condition precedent of his election.</p>

The above amendments were regularly Proposed and Seconded in open Lodge at a regular Meeting held on 20th February, 2010. Passed at a regular Meeting held on 20th March, 2010. and confirmed at a regular Meeting held on 17th April, 2010.
