Know YE that We by the authority and under the sanction of Grand Lodge of India vested in us for that purpose and at the humble petition of our right Trusty and well beloved Brethren Mathew Thomas, Malickal Damodaran George, Puthanpurayil Mahesh Gopalan, Narikunni Jayanth, Ranjit Sahadevan, Srinivas Rabindranath Pai, Rabindranath Narendranath Pai, Kokkera Subbaiah Vasu, Harishankar Pockyarat, Babu Rabindran Theeyancheri Nadubileveetil, Richard Hay, Puthanpurayil Mohan, Gopal Hirendra Kamath, Koyadan Koroth Chandran, Manohar Hirendra Kamath, Jayanandan Parayil, Sanjeev Kumar Madakkabil, Kurupath Vasupurath Venugopal, Ramesh Rayu, Naveen Kodoth, Achinal Karubanballapil Shereef, Kunhalu Parerkal Kamaluddin, Dibakar Hirendra Kamath, Pramod Koyili, Narayana Prasad Karakkad, Rohit Raghavan, Alora Puthiyaveetil Anil Kumar, Sivaramakrishnan Kasiviswanathan, Chernicheri Veetil Sabari Das, Mohan Chandran Pattipunna Unkalath, Thomas Chirayath Joseph and Sekharapuram Subramanian Mahadevan do hereby constitute the said Brethren into a Lodge of Free and Accepted Masons under the title or Denomination of

LODGE WESTERN STAR NO. 363

the said Lodge to meet at Freemasons' Hall, Talap, Kannur on Third Sunday of February, April, June, August, October and December empowering them in the said Lodge when duly congregated to make, pass and raise Freemasons according to the Ancient customs of the Craft in all Ages and Nations throughout the known world. And further at their said Petition and of the great trust and confidence reposed in every one of the above named brethren WE DO APPOINT the said MATHEW THOMAS to be the first Master, the said MALICKAL DAMODARAN GEORGE to be the first Senior Warden and the said PUTHANPURAYIL MAHESH GOPALAN to be the first Junior Warden for opening and holding the said Lodge and until such time as another Master shall be regularly elected and installed, strictly charging the every member who shall be elected to preside over the said Lodge who must previously have duly served as Warden in a Warranted Lodge shall be installed in Ancient Form and according to the laws of The Grand Lodge that he may thereby be fully invested with the dignities and power of his office.

AND WE DO REQUIRE you the said MATHEW THOMAS to take Special care that all and every one of the said Brethren are or have been regularly made Masons and that you and they and all other Members of the said Lodge do observe, perform and keep the Laws, Rules and Orders contained in the Book of Constitutions and all others which may from time to time be made by our Grand Lodge or transmitted by us or our Successor Grand Masters, or by our Deputy Grand Master for the time being and we do enjoin you to make such Bye-Laws for the Government of your Lodge as shall to the majority of the Members appear proper and necessary, the same not being contrary to or inconsistent with the General Laws and Regulations of the Craft, a Copy whereof you are to transmit to us.


AND WE DO REQUIRE you to cause all such Bye-Laws and Regulations and also an account of the proceedings in your Lodge to be entered in a Book to be kept for that purpose. And you are in no wise to omit to send us or our Successor Grand Masters or to Our Deputy Grand Master for the time being at least once in every year a list of the members of your Lodge and the names and descriptions of all Masons initiated therein and Brethren who shall have joined the same with the fees and monies payable thereon.

IT BEING OUR WILL and intention that this OUR WARRANT OF CONSTITUTION shall continue in force so long only as you shall conform to the Laws and Regulations of our Grand Lodge. And you the said MATHEW THOMAS are further required as soon as conveniently may be to send us an Account in writing of whatever shall be done by virtue of these Presents.

Given under our hand and seal of the Grand Lodge at New Delhi this Fifth day of March 2009 A.D. corresponding to 14th day of PHALGUNA 1930 Saka Era.
